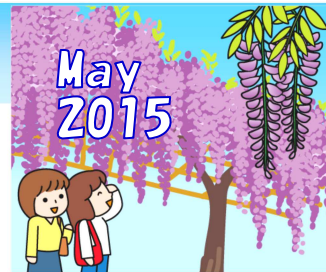


Events in Higashihiroshima

Date & Time: Sunday 17th May, 14:30 (doors open 14:00)

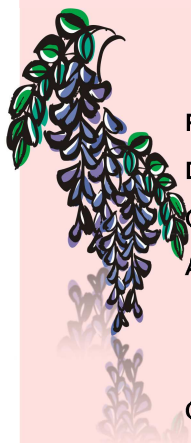
Place: Saijo Sakagura-dori Tourist Information Center (2F, Kugurimon)
