

Sake Matsuri (Sake Festival) 2014

2014酒まつり

The 2014 Sake Festival (Sake Matsuri) will be held in Saijo on Saturday October 11th and Sunday October 12th. The festival is held in the area around JR Saijo Station. There are a wide range of events and attractions, including the Sake Hiroba (where, for a fee of 1600 yen for tickets bought in advance, or 2100 yen for tickets bought on the day, you can taste sake from across Japan). There is also the Bishu-nabe area (where, for a fee, you can try bishu-nabe, a Saijo speciality), and the sake breweries themselves, where there are sake tastings, concerts, etc. Please be sure to pay a visit to the festival!

The Bishu-nabe area is located in the car-park of the City Office, and the Sake Hiroba is located in Saijo Central Park. It is possible to buy advance tickets for the Sake Hiroba, and it is necessary to make reservations for the Bishu-nabe area. Reservations for bishu-nabe can be made from September 26th until October 5th. Please note the following regarding the Sake Matsuri:

- The main City Office car-park will not be available for use from 17:45 on Wednesday October 8th to 18:00 on Monday October 13th. There will be alternative parking available on Thursday October 9th and Friday October 10th for those who have business at the City Office. Please follow the directions given by staff.
- The Central Lifelong Learning Center will not be available for use at any time on Friday October 10th, Saturday October 11th, and Sunday October 12th.
- The bicycle-parking area on the north side of the City Office will not be available for use between 6:00 on Thursday October 9th and 12:00 on Monday October 13th. During this period, there will be alternative parking available in the Okamachi car park.
- The Central Park in Saijo will not be open from Monday October 6th.
- Other facilities may also be closed or have restricted opening hours, etc.
- There will be road closures and diversions in effect during the Sake Matsuri.
- Because of construction work at JR Saijo Station, the area around the station is expected to be even more crowded than usual during the Sake Matsuri.

Scheduled vaccinations against chicken pox for children will begin from October 1st

Children in the following categories who are residents of Higashihiroshima City are eligible for scheduled vaccinations against chicken pox. These vaccinations are free for eligible children.

① Children aged 1 or 2 (2 vaccinations)

(2) (Only for the 2014-2015 financial year) Children aged 3 or 4 (1 vaccination)

However, those who have already had chicken pox are not eligible.

In addition, those who have already had optional vaccinations against chicken pox (including children aged 3 or 4) will be eligible only for any remaining doses of vaccination they have not already had.

Standard vaccination schedule for two-dose chicken pox vaccination:

Initial dose: children aged between 12 and 15 months.

Booster dose: 6 to 12 months after the initial dose.

If the standard schedule is not appropriate for a child, then the booster dose will be administered once a period of three months or more has passed since the original dose.

A list of medical facilities in Higashihiroshima City able to administer these vaccinations will be made available on the City homepage, and in the October edition of the City newsletter. Vaccination questionnaires will be available at facilities where the vaccinations are available.

At the Recycling Fair, out-of-date foreign newspapers and magazines will be available for free.


There will be a free shuttle bus between JR Saijo Station and the International Plaza.

A bus tour around Higashihiroshima for foreign residents will be held on Sunday September 28th, from 10:00 to 17:30. Deadline for payment of taxes: Tuesday September 30th

Please pay the National Health Insurance Premium (the third installment) by Tuesday September 30th. A notice of non-payment (Tokusokujo, 督促状) will be sent to residents who have not paid their tax by the deadline. If you receive a Tokusokujo, please pay the tax immediately, using the payment slip enclosed.

* Note: it takes about ten days for the Tax Collection Division to confirm payment of tax, and therefore you may receive a Tokusokujo even after you have completed payment. In this case, please ignore the letter. Contact: Tax Collection Division (Shuno-ka, 収納課), tel.: 082-420-0912.

Night-time and holiday hospitals

Full information about night-time and holiday duty hospitals (Primary Emergency Medical Care Hospitals) is published in the Japanese-language version of the monthly city newsletter 'Higashihiroshima'. You can also find this information (in English and Japanese) on the 'Kyukyu Iryo Net Hiroshima' site (http://www.gg.pref.hiroshima.jp). You will be able to find information about which medical facility to go to, and what times the facilities are open (Higashihiroshima City is in the 'Hiroshima Chuo' area). Please use the QR Code on the right if you are accessing the site from a mobile phone. The information on the site may be subject to change at short notice, so please contact the medical facility to confirm the information. Details of medical facilities open on holidays and at night are also available by phone: 0120-169901 (Japanese), or 0120-169912 (English).



About emergency medical treatment

In the case of an injury or a sudden fever or illness, where you cannot decide whether the symptoms are serious or not, first of all go to a 'Primary Emergency Medical Care Hospital'. If the symptoms are serious, and emergency surgery or hospitalization is required, the doctor will provide an introductory letter for a 'Secondary Emergency Medical Care Hospital'. If the symptoms are clearly serious, do not hesitate to go to a Secondary Emergency Medical Care Hospital, or call 119 to summon an ambulance.

For details of Secondary Emergency Medical Care hospitals, where patients with serious symptoms can be treated, contact Higashihiroshima City Fire Department (tel.: 082-422-0119).

Higashihiroshima City Holiday Clinic (Kyujitsu Shinryosho,休日診療所) is a facility that can provide emergency treatment in the case of a sudden medical problem, for those who cannot get treatment anywhere else.
