Vaccinations against measles and German measles (rubella)

Children can very easily catch measles and German measles (rubella) from each other, and vaccinations are important to protect your child from these illnesses.Children aged 1 can be given the first dose vaccination, and children born between April 2nd, 2008 and April 1st, 2009 (children in the final year of kindergarten or nursery school) can be given the second dose vaccination. If your child has not yet been vaccinated against these illnesses, please have him/her vaccinated as soon as possible, on a day when he/she is not suffering from any illnesses. The deadline for

vaccinations (free of charge) for those eligible for the second dose vaccination is Tuesday March 31st, 2015. Applications are not necessary. Please make a reservation directly at a medical facility with Higashihiroshima City which offers these vaccinations (for details, please see the City website). If you wish to have your child vaccinated at a facility outside the city, it is necessary to complete paperwork in advance. Please be sure to contact the Children and Family Support Division or one of the branch offices of the City Office. Pre-vaccination questionnaires are available from the Children and Family Support Division, from branch offices and sub-branch offices of the City Office, and from medical facilities offering vaccinations.

Changes to JR Saijo Station



JR西条駅南北自由通路が開 通します

Work on the new JR Saijo Station is almost complete, and the bridge joining the north and south sides of the station (the route through the station) will open on Sunday January 25th. It will be possible to walk through the station from the south side (where the bus-stops are located) to the north side, where new bicycle- and car-parking areas will also open for use on the same date.



Higashihiroshima City will hold a ceremony to celebrate the coming-of-age of those born between April 2nd, 1994 and April 1st, 1995. The ceremony will be held in the gymnasium of the Higashihiroshima Sports Ground (Aquapark), on Monday 12th January, from 11:00 to 12:30. The doors will open at 10:15. The ceremony will take place from 11:00 to 11:30, and from 11:40 to 12:30 there will be a 'talk show' by Shogo Kimura, a player with the Hiroshima Carp baseball team. Even those (born between the dates above) whose address is not registered as Higashihiroshima City are welcome to take part, by registering on the day. Also, anyone is welcome to attend the talk show. Car-parking is limited. Please share cars with others attending the ceremony wherever possible. Deadline for payment of taxes: Monday February 2nd

1月の納税・納期限は 2月2日(月)

Please pay Municipal and Prefectural Tax (the fourth installment) and the National Health Insurance Premium (the seventh installment) by Monday February 2nd.

A notice of non-payment (Tokusokujo, 督促状) will be sent to residents who have not paid their tax by the deadline. If you receive a Tokusokujo, please pay the tax immediately, using the payment slip enclosed.

* Note: it takes about ten days for the Tax Collection Division to confirm payment of tax, and therefore you may receive a Tokusokujo even after you have completed payment. In this case, please ignore the letter.

You will be able to find information about which medical facility to go to, and what times the facilities are open (Higashihiroshima City is in the 'Hiroshima Chuo' area). Please use the QR Code on the right if you are accessing the site from a mobile phone. The information on the site may be subject to change at short notice, so please contact the medical facility to confirm the information. Details of change at short notice, and heiden and a pight are also also here and a pight be by phone.



medical facilities open on holidays and at night are also available by phone: 0120-169901 (in Japanese).

About emergency medical treatment

In the case of an injury or a sudden fever or illness, where you cannot decide whether the symptoms are serious or not, first of all go to a 'Primary Emergency Medical Care Hospital'. If the symptoms are serious, and emergency surgery or hospitalization is required, the doctor will provide an introductory letter for a 'Secondary Emergency Medical Care Hospital'. If the symptoms are clearly serious, do not hesitate to go to a Secondary Emergency Medical Care Hospital, or call 119 to summon an ambulance.

For details of Secondary Emergency Medical Care hospitals, where patients with serious symptoms can be treated, contact Higashihiroshima City Fire Department (tel.: 082-422-0119).

Higashihiroshima City Holiday Clinic (Kyujitsu Shinryosho, 休日診療所) is a facility that can provide emergency treatment in the case of a sudden medical problem, for those who cannot get treatment anywhere else. Medical Departments: internal medicine, pediatrics and dentistry.

• Open: Sundays, holidays, year-end and New Year holidays (Dec. 31 - Jan. 3). Hours: 9:00 - 12:00, 13:00 - 16:00

From December 31, 2014 to March 8, 2015, the internal medicine and pediatrics departments are open until 20:00. On Sunday January 18, the internal medicine and pediatrics departments are open until 22:00.

Call Center for Emergency First-aid for Children (Kodomo-kyukyu-denwa-sodan, こどもの救急電話相談), tel.: #8000 (from a normal phone or mobile phone) or 082-505-1399 (from an IP phone or hikari phone). Available 365 days a year, from 19:00 to 8:00 the following morning. Only in Japanese.
