# Human rights counselling in languages other than Japanese

There is a dedicated human rights counselling telephone service available for those who cannot speak Japanese well. Available languages are English, Chinese, Korean, Filipino, Portuguese, and Vietnamese.

You can make use of this service from anywhere in Japan, by dialling 0570-090911 (please be careful that you do not dial the wrong number). The service is available on weekdays (year-end/new year period excepted) from 9:00 to 17:00. When you make use of this service, you will be connected to a company providing multi-language telephone interpretation, and you will be able to speak to a regional Legal Affairs Bureau.

#### Don't let children play in ponds or streams- it's dangerous! ・ ため池や水路で 遊ばないで!

There are approximately 4000 ponds and reservoirs within Higashihiroshima City. These ponds are extremely dangerous, because the water in the ponds can be very deep, making it difficult to climb out if you fall in.

With the beginning of the new school year, new students can be very inquisitive about ponds and streams close to their route to school. Families and everyone in the community should join forces to make sure there are no accidents where children fall into these ponds or streams.

Families should familiarize themselves with the dangerous places (ponds, etc.) in their neighborhood, and parents should tell their children, over and over again, that they should never go near these ponds, etc.

People in the community should warn any children they see playing near a pond, etc., that it is dangerous, and that they should not play there.

The Citizens' Affairs Division is expected to be very busy during April, because of the large numbers of people moving into and out of Higashihiroshima City at this time of year. If you need to visit the Citizens' Affairs Division during April, please allow plenty of time.

In addition to normal opening hours, the Citizens' Affairs Division will be open on Sunday April 8th and Sunday April 22nd, from 8:30 to 12:30. The division is also open each Thursday (national holidays and the end of year period excepted) until 19:00.

Only certain services are available on the Sundays above, and during extended service hours on Thursdays, and some paperwork may require that another office is contacted, in which case the formalities may not be able to be completed immediately. Also, on April 22nd, the My Number system will be undergoing maintenance, so no formalities relating to the My Number scheme will be possible. Please make sure that you take official identification with you (photo identification, such as a driving license, your Residence Card, etc.).

Ön Saturday March 31st and Sunday April 1st, applications relating to changes of address (moving into or out of Higashihiroshima City, or moving house within the city) can be accepted between 8:30 and 12:30. Contact: Citizens' Affairs Division (Shimin-ka, 市民課), tel.: 082-420-0925.

# Deadline for payment of taxes: Tuesday May 1st

Please pay Fixed Asset Tax and City Planning Tax (the first payment) by Tuesday May 1st.

A notice of non-payment (Tokusokujo, 督促状) will be sent to residents who have not paid their tax by the deadline. If you receive a Tokusokujo, please pay the tax immediately, using the payment slip enclosed.

\* Note: it takes about ten days for the Tax Collection Division to confirm payment of tax, and therefore you may receive a Tokusokujo even after you have completed payment. In this case, please ignore the letter.

### Night-time and holiday hospitals

The information is also available (in Japanese and automatically-translated English) on the 'Kyukyu Iryo Net Hiroshima' site (http://www.qq.pref.hiroshima.jp). You will be able to find information about which medical facility to go to, and what times the facilities are open. The information on the site may be subject to change at short notice, so please contact the medical facility to confirm the information.

#### About emergency medical treatment

In the case of an injury or a sudden fever or illness, where you cannot decide whether the symptoms are serious or not, first of all go to a 'Primary Emergency Medical Care Hospital'. If the symptoms are serious, and emergency surgery or hospitalization is required, the doctor will provide an introductory letter for a 'Secondary Emergency Medical Care Hospital'. If the symptoms are clearly serious, do not hesitate to go to a Secondary Emergency Medical Care Hospital, or call 119 to summon an ambulance. For details of Secondary Emergency Medical Care hospitals, where patients with serious symptoms can be treated, contact Higashihiroshima City Fire Department (tel.: 082-422-0119).

**Higashihiroshima City Holiday Clinic** (Kyujitsu Shinryosho, 休日診療所) is a facility that can provide emergency treatment in the case of a sudden medical problem, for those who cannot get treatment anywhere else. Medical Departments: internal medicine, pediatrics and dentistry.

• Open: Sundays, holidays, year-end and New Year holidays (Dec. 30 - Jan. 3). Hours: 9:00 - 12:00, 13:00 - 16:00

On Sunday April 8th, Sunday April 15th, and Sunday April 30th, the internal medicine and pediatrics departments are open until 21:00.

**Call Center for Emergency First-aid for Children** (Kodomo-kyukyu-denwa-sodan, こどもの救急電話相談), tel.: #8000 (from a normal phone or mobile phone) or 082-505-1399 (from an IP phone or hikari phone). Available 365 days a year, from 19:00 to 8:00 the following morning. Only in Japanese.


