1. Pregnancy (妊娠)

When you become pregnant (妊娠したら)

Notification of pregnancy (*Ninshin Todokede-sho*, 妊娠届出書)

Enquiries: Children and Family Support Division (Tel: 082-420-0407)

If you become pregnant, submit a Notification of Pregnancy to the Children and Family Support Division or Community Sukusuku Support. You will obtain a Mother and Child Health Handbook and a Higashihiroshima Sukusuku Plan (booklet), and will receive guidance on each system from pregnancy to child-rearing, as well as consultation on any concerns.

Mother and Child Health Handbook (*Boshi Kenko Techo*, 母子健康手帳)

Enquiries: Children and Family Support Division (Tel: 082-420-0407)

After submitting a Notification of Pregnancy, you will receive a Mother and Child Health Handbook and a separate volume containing vouchers for examinations (*Boshi Kenko Techo Bessatsu Jushin Setto*, 母子健康手帳別冊受診券セット). This handbook will be used from the early stage of your pregnancy until your child begins attending elementary school, and provides an integrated health register for mother and child. English versions are available. Take the handbook with you when you or your child undergo medical examinations, health consultations and vaccinations.

If you are moving to Higashihiroshima City from another municipality in Japan, you are not required to change your handbook.

'Sukusuku' pregnancy and childbirth support center (*Ninshin/Shussan Support Center Sukusuku*, 妊娠・出産サポートセンターすくすく)

Mother and Child health coordinators (with qualifications as health workers or midwives) provide support from pregnancy to childbirth, so that mothers can raise their children without worries.

Location: Children and Family Support Division, Higashihiroshima City Office (open weekdays 8:30-17:15, tel.: 082-420-0407)

Sukusuku Support provides the following services:

1. Issuing Mother and Child Health Handbooks
2. The before- and after-birth 'Mama Helper' scheme and the 'Multiple Childbirth Supporter' scheme
3. Maternity classes, mother and father classes (Papa mama classes), working maternity classes
4. Support and advice (face-to-face, telephone, home visits) from pregnancy to child-raising.
5. After-birth care (one-day, overnight, or visit)
6. Feeding advice
7. Refresh classes for mothers who have given birth

- Community Sukusuku Support brings Sukusuku Support closer to mothers

With the aim of creating an environment where it is easier to ask questions and get advice, Sukusuku Support is available at child-raising support centers in 12 locations across the city. Sukusuku Support can be used from the period of pregnancy, so please feel free to visit one of the support centers.

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Expectant mothers' health care (妊婦の健康管理)

Prenatal Medical Examination (*Ninpu Kenko Shinsa*, 妊婦健康診査)

Enquiries: Children and Family Support Division (Tel: 082-420-0407)

A total of 14 health examinations, etc. (19 for multiple births) during pregnancy will be supported by grants. The separate volume of the Mother and Child Health Handbook (containing examination vouchers) includes Prenatal Medical Examination Vouchers. Using these vouchers, you can receive medical examinations at a medical facility in Hiroshima Prefecture. If you want to use the vouchers at medical facilities or maternity hospitals outside Hiroshima Prefecture, please consult the relevant division.

If you change your address to another municipality, you will not be able to use these vouchers there. Please direct any enquiries to the municipality you are moving to. If you have moved into Higashihiroshima City, the vouchers issued by your previous municipality need to be changed to those of this city.

Prenatal Dental Health Examination (*Ninpu Shika Kenko Shinsa*, 妊婦歯科健康診査)

Pregnant women can receive a free dental health examination once during pregnancy at a medical facility designated by Higashihiroshima City. The separate volume of the Mother and Child Health Handbook (containing examination vouchers) includes a Prenatal Dental Health Examination Voucher (orange color). Please use this voucher when you see a dentist (appointments are required).

Matters related to changing your address (moving from Higashihiroshima City to another municipality, or moving from another municipality to Higashihiroshima City) are the same as for Prenatal Medical Examinations.

Mentoring-style Consultation Support (Odekake Sukusuku) (Banso-gata Sodan Shien, 伴走型相談支援)

● Support benefits for pregnant women

Support is provided to reduce the financial burden of childbirth and childcare purchases, etc., so that new mothers can spend their pregnancy, childbirth, and child-raising period with peace of mind. If you have moved to the city, please consult us when you have completed the procedures for the transfer.

- Contents (1): We discuss matters with the pregnant woman when she notifies us of her pregnancy, provide the application form, and accept the application.

Amount of payment: 50,000 yen

• Contents (2): After notifying us of the number of children you are expecting, the mother can make an application eight weeks before the expected date of delivery or later. We can accept the application at this time.

Amount of payment: 50,000 yen x the number of children you are pregnant with

●Odekake Sukusuku

We provide mentoring-style consultation support that provides consultation and necessary support close to you from pregnancy to childbirth and child-raising. Eligible individuals will receive a personal notification. After a discussion of matters at Sukusuku Support, support items will be handed over to you.

(1) Sukusapo (Sukusuku Support) debut for pregnant women

Target: Pregnant women around 8 months pregnant (generally after 24 weeks)

Contents: Products for preparing for childbirth

(2) Sukusapo debut for parents and children

Target: Mothers with children around 4 months old

Contents: Childcare support products

(3) Book debut for parents and children

Target: Mothers with children around 7 months old

Contents: Book debut set

Child-raising knowledge（子育ての知識）

Papa Mama Classes (*Papa mama kyoshitsu*, パパママ教室)

Enquiries: Children and Family Support Division (Tel: 082-420-0407)

In Papa Mama Classes, parents who are expecting a baby can learn about delivery and child-raising. Participating in these classes during the stable period, i.e. six to eight months into a pregnancy, is recommended.

- Target: Pregnant women, and their partners
- Content: Bathing experience (how to give your baby a bath), experience of being a pregnant father, parent-child interaction (talking to the baby in the womb)
- What to bring: Mother and Child Health Handbook, writing instruments
- How to apply: Make an appointment (first-come first-served basis)

Maternity Classes (*Maternity kyoshitsu*, マタニティ教室)

Enquiries: Children and Family Support Division (Tel: 082-420-0407)

In maternity classes, pregnant women can learn about what should be prepared before having a child, health care while pregnant and new-born baby care. These classes will also provide opportunities to interact with other pregnant women. Participating in these classes during the stable period, i.e. six to eight months into a pregnancy, is recommended.

- Target: Pregnant women who can participate in both scheduled classes
- Content: (1st session) Midwives and nutritionists will talk about pregnancy, childbirth, and how to spend the period after birth, etc.
(2nd session) Baby care, after-birth support, etc.
- What to bring: Mother and Child Health Handbook, writing instruments
- How to apply: Make an appointment (first-come-first-served basis)

Working Maternity Classes (*Working maternity kyoshitsu*, ワーキングマタニティ教室)

Enquiries: Children and Family Support Division (Tel: 082-420-0407)

Classes for pregnant women who are at work on weekdays, making it difficult to attend weekday classes. These classes are a good opportunity to learn about giving birth and child-raising, from the perspective of working mothers.

- Target: Women with jobs who are pregnant for the first time
- Content: Advice about giving birth in general, about taking care of your baby, and about pregnancy, giving birth and child raising for working mothers, discussion of support
- How to apply: Make an appointment (first-come-first-served basis)

2. Childbirth (出産)

Necessary notifications (必要な届出)

Birth Registration (*Shussei Todoke*, 出生届)

Enquiries: Citizens' Affairs Division (Tel: 082-420-0915)

Foreign nationals living in Japan are also required to inform the City Office when they give birth in Japan. This procedure can be done at a Branch Office or a Sub-branch Office of the city in your neighborhood. In addition, you must apply for a Certificate of Items Recorded on the Birth Registration (*Shussei Todoke Kisai Jiko Shomeisho*, 出生届記載事項証明書) (a document to prove that a Birth Registration has been accepted) when the need arises, such as obtaining the Status of Residence for your newborn baby.

- Registration period: Within 14 days from the day of delivery (including the day of delivery)
- Notifying person: The child's father or mother must sign the form (If the father/mother cannot come to the City Office, they can entrust a proxy to submit the registration form.)
- What to bring: Birth Registration (with details of the hospital where the child was born in the Birth Certificate space), Mother and Child Health Handbook

☆ When having given birth in a hospital: Obtain a Birth Registration form at the hospital after the delivery.

Procedures for joining National Health Insurance (*Kokumin Kenko-hoken*, 国民健康保険)

Enquiries: National Health Insurance and Pension Division (Tel: 082-420-0933)

If your newborn baby is not covered by health insurance, the baby must be enrolled in the National Health Insurance system. You may complete the procedures at a Branch Office or a Sub-branch Office of the city in your neighborhood. It is recommended that you complete these procedures along with the Birth Registration.

If a parent/caregiver of the newborn baby is enrolled in corporate health insurance, they should enquire about their baby's health insurance with their company.

- What to bring: a document identifying the person who has given birth (a Residence Card, etc.), and a document showing the individual number ('My Number') of the head of the household.

Obtaining Status of Residence (*Zairyu Shikaku*, 在留資格)

Enquiries: Hiroshima Regional Immigration Bureau

You are required to apply for your baby's status of residence within 30 days from the birth.

- What to bring: Certificate of Items Recorded on the Birth Registration (*Shussei Todoke Kisai Jiko Shomeisho*, 出生届書記載事項証明書), parents' Residence Cards, parents' passports, Mother and Child Health Handbook, copy of the Certificate of Residence (*Juminhyo*, 住民票) showing all recorded details of all family members.

For details, please contact the Hiroshima Regional Immigration Bureau.

Obtaining nationality (*Kokuseki*, 国籍)

- If one of the parents holds Japanese nationality:

If either the father or mother is Japanese and they are legally married, the baby to be born is entitled to Japanese nationality.

If the father holds Japanese nationality, the mother holds foreign nationality and they are not legally married, their child is not entitled to Japanese nationality unless the father admits fathering the child. If the father files a notification of the acknowledgment of the fetus, the fetus becomes entitled to Japanese nationality at the time of the birth. However, if the father files a notification of the acknowledgment of the baby after the birth, obtaining the baby's Japanese nationality requires completion of the regular procedures at the Legal Affairs Bureau.

If one parent holds foreign nationality, the other holds Japanese nationality and they are not legally married, in order for the child to obtain the nationality of the foreign parent, the same procedures as in a case where both parents hold foreign nationality should be followed. For further details, please contact the Embassy or Consulate of your country in Japan.

- If both parents hold foreign nationality:

If both parents hold foreign nationality, their child is not entitled to Japanese nationality even if the child was born in Japan. The procedure for obtaining the child's nationality must comply with his/her parents' countries' laws. Since this matter is handled differently by each country, please confirm how to complete the procedure and obtain all necessary documents at the Embassy or Consulate of your country in Japan.

Payment of allowances (各種手当の支給)

Payment of Lump-sum Maternity Allowance (*Shussan Ikuji Ichiji-kin*, 出産育児一時金) of National Health Insurance

Enquiries: National Health Insurance and Pension Division (Tel: 082-420-0933)

When a person who is enrolled in the National Health Insurance Scheme gives birth (including miscarriages and stillbirths on or after 85 days of pregnancy), a Lump-sum Maternity Allowance is paid by the city. This payment can be made directly from the city to the hospital in which the child was born. If you use this system, the procedures can be completed at the hospital (no procedures at the City Office are necessary), and the amount of money you will need to pay yourself at the hospital will be reduced.

If you do not want to take advantage of this direct payment arrangement, you will need to pay the full costs of the childbirth yourself at the hospital. You will then need to apply at the City Office for the allowance to be paid to you.

Whichever system you use, if the cost of the birth is less than the amount of the allowance, you must notify the City Office after the birth. In the case of childbirth overseas, please consult the City Office.

- What to bring: The documents regarding direct payment issued by the hospital, etc., the receipt & bill for the childbirth costs, a bankbook (showing the account number) in the name of the head of your household

Exemption from National Pension payments in the period before and after childbirth (Sanzen-sango kikan no Kokumin Kenko Hokenzei no menjo, 産前産後期間の国民健康保険税の免除)

Enquiries: National Health Insurance and Pension Division (Tel: 082-420-0933)

When a person enrolled in National Health Insurance gives birth (including stillbirth, miscarriage, and premature birth after more than 85 days of pregnancy), they can apply for exemption from the income-related portion and per capita portion of National Health Insurance tax for the period before and after childbirth. National Health Insurance tax equivalent to 4 months, from the month before the month in which the due date or delivery date falls (for woman pregnant with multiple children, National Health Insurance tax equivalent to 6 months, from 3 months before the month in which the due date or delivery date falls) is covered. You can submit the paperwork from 6 months before the expected date of delivery.

- What to bring: Mother and Child Health Handbook, personal identification for the person submitting the paperwork (driving license, etc.), document showing the My Number for the head of the household

Exemption from National Pension payments in the period before and after childbirth (Sanzen-sango kikan no Kokumin Nenkin Hokenryo no menjo, 産前産後期間の国民年金保険料の免除)

Enquiries: National Health Insurance and Pension Division (Tel: 082-420-0933)

When a person enrolled in the National Pension Scheme gives birth (including a stillbirth on or after the 85th day of pregnancy, a miscarriage or a premature birth), it is possible to apply for an exemption from National Pension payments in the period before and after childbirth. This exemption begins from the month before the month in which the due date or the date of birth falls, and applies to four months' National Pension payments. In the case of a multiple pregnancy, the exemption begins from the month three before the month in which the due date or the date of birth falls, and applies to six months' National Pension payments. Applications can be accepted from six months before the due date.

- What to bring: Mother and Child Health Handbook (if applying before giving birth), personal identification for the person submitting the paperwork (driving license, etc.)

Child Allowance (*Jido Teate*, 児童手当)

Enquiries: Children and Family Support Division (Tel: 082-420-0941)

This allowance is paid to persons who are raising a child aged between 0 and 18, until the time the child finishes high school (i.e. until the first March 31 after the child reaches 18 years old). Payment of the allowance starts from the month after the month of application. If you have just moved into Higashihiroshima City from another city, you are required to apply again for this allowance. The application form can be downloaded from Higashihiroshima City's website, and submission by mail is also accepted. Since your application will be accepted even if you have not yet prepared all of the necessary documents, early submission of the application form is recommended.

- Application period: Within the month of birth or moving into Higashihiroshima City, or within 15 days of the day following the birth or moving into Higashihiroshima City. (Any delay in applying may

mean that the date from which you can receive the allowance is also delayed.)

- Amount of monthly payments:

Children under 3 years of age:

First child, second child: 15,000 yen

Third child: 30,000 yen

Children between age 3 and an age equivalent to the end of high school:

First child, second child: 10,000 yen

Third child: 30,000 yen

- What to bring: Document showing the health insurance qualification information of the applicant (the parent/caregiver of the child who is the main breadwinner) (this is not necessary if the applicant is enrolled in the National Pension System (*Kokumin Nenkin*, 国民年金)), a bankbook in the name of the applicant, passports of the mother and father (in the case of applicants moving into Higashihiroshima City from outside Japan)

Medical Expenses Payments Scheme for Children (*Kodomo Iryo-hi no shikyu*, こども医療費の支給)

Enquiries: Children and Family Support Division (Tel: 082-420-0941)

This is a system by which hospital charges for children are provided. A Certificate of Eligibility for Subsidy of Medical Expenses for Children (*Kodomo Iryo-hi Jukyusha-sho*, こども医療費受給者証) will be issued. When your child sees a doctor or is hospitalized, please show the certificate along with a document showing the health insurance qualification information at the hospital.

- Application period: Within 14 days from the date of childbirth or of moving into Higashihiroshima City. (Any delay in submitting the application results in the providing from the day of application.)
- Eligibility: • Children aged from 0 to until the first March 31 after the child reaches 18 years of age (i.e. children up to the end of high school)
- Amount of subsidy: The amount exceeding the amount payable as an individual contribution will be covered, for medical costs for which health insurance can be used.
In the case of prescriptions and prosthetic devices from pharmacies where health insurance can be used, no individual contribution is payable.

(The amount payable as an individual contribution is a maximum of 500 yen per day per medical institution, with a limit of up to 14 days per month per medical institution for inpatients, and 4 days per month per medical institution for outpatients)

- What to bring: A document showing your child's health insurance qualification information, the passports of the mother and father (if you have moved to Higashihiroshima City from another country),
- Note: If you change your address or Health Insurance Certificate, you must notify the City Office.

Requesting Refunds of Medical Expenses Payments for Children & Medical Costs Paid by Single

Parents (Reimbursements) (Kodomo Iryo-hi・Hitori-oya Iryo-hi no Henkan-seikyu (Shokan harai), こども医療費・ひとり親医療費の返還請求 (償還払い))

Enquiries: Children and Family Support Division (Tel: 082-420-0941)

Within the period of validity of the Certificate of Eligibility for Subsidy of Medical Expenses for Children or the Certificate of Eligibility for Subsidy of Medical Expenses of Single-parent Families, etc. (see the section “Subsidies for medical expenses of single-parent families, etc.”), medical costs incurred before the issuance of these certificates, and medical costs incurred outside Hiroshima Prefecture, can be refunded. However, any medical costs paid for treatment not covered by health insurance and the individual contribution amounts are not refundable.

- What to bring: Certificate of eligibility for subsidy of medical costs for infants/toddlers or certificate of eligibility for subsidy of medical costs of single-parent families, etc., a document showing the health insurance qualification information, receipts of hospital charges (showing the amount paid, name of the medical examinee and insurance points), bankbook (in the name of the child's parent/caregiver shown on the relevant certificate of eligibility, as mentioned above)

Payment of subsidies for nursing and medical treatment of children (medical aid for premature infants) (Yoiku Iryo (Mijukuji Iryo), 養育医療 (未熟児医療))

If a doctor finds that in-hospital nursing is necessary for a premature newborn baby weighing 2,000g or less at the time of birth, part or all of the medical costs for the treatment at a designated medical institution will be paid (subsidy for medical costs). The maximum amount you have to cover yourself varies depending on the income of your household.

- What to bring: doctor's written opinion regarding nursing/medical treatment for the premature baby, Mother and Child Health Handbook, Health Insurance Certificate (for the infant in question or for the person having a duty to support the infant), a document showing the applicant's individual number ('My Number')

Payment of subsidies for medical care to support independence (rehabilitative treatment for disabled children) (Jiritsu Shien Iryo (Ikusei Iryo), 自立支援医療 (育成医療))

If a child aged under 18 has a disability (a physical disability, impaired sight, etc.), and it is deemed that with surgery this condition could be improved, part of the costs of the treatment will be paid. If you are eligible to receive this payment, the amount you have to cover yourself is as a rule 10% of the medical costs, but this can vary depending on the income of your household.

- What to bring: doctor's written opinion regarding medical care to support independence (rehabilitative treatment), Health Insurance Certificates for each member of the household, a document showing the applicant's individual number ('My Number')

In the case of disabled children (障害児の場合)

Health care for mothers and babies (母親と赤ちゃんの健康管理)

Home visit to families with infants (Hello Baby Visit) (*Nyuji Katei Zenko Homon (Konnichiwa Akachan Homon)*, 乳児家庭全戸訪問 (こんにちは赤ちゃん訪問))

Enquiries: Children and Family Support Division (Tel: 082-420-0407)

This service is intended for all newborn babies. Public health nurses or midwives visit your home, and measure the baby's body weight and provide child-raising advice.

After childbirth, please complete the formalities to apply online for the visit from the Citizens' Portal Site. When your preferred date is close, you will receive a telephone call from the City with full details of the date and time.

In particular, if your baby was less than 2500g at birth, a notification is necessary.

Refresh classes for mothers who have given birth (*Sango no mama no refresh koza*, 産後のママのリフレッシュ講座)

Classes to help mothers who have given birth, if they are feeling in a bad condition.

- Target: Mothers between one month (after the one-month health checkup) and six months after giving birth (mothers can bring their children to the classes)
- Content: Changes to the body after giving birth, posture, etc. (light exercise is included)
- How to apply: Make an appointment (places are allocated on a first-come-first-served basis)

Health check for new mothers (*Sanpu kenshin*, 産婦健診)

Health checks are available at medical facilities for mothers, two weeks and one month after giving birth. The mother's health, as well as the state of breast feeding and child-raising, are checked.

After-childbirth Care Scheme (*Sango care jigyo*, 産後ケア事業)

The after-childbirth care scheme helps mothers rest and receive counselling to get rid of worries with anxiety about childcare.

- Eligibility: Those who have a resident registration in Higashihiroshima City and meet either of the following criteria:
 - (1) Women who have given birth and infants under one year old, who require after-birth care
 - (2) Those who have experienced a miscarriage or stillbirth within the past year

- Content: (1) One-Day Care: Fee 2,000 yen

Location: accommodation, medical facilities and maternity hospitals in the city

- (2) Overnight Care: Fee 7,500 yen (15,000 yen for 2 days and 1 night),

Location: medical facilities in the city, maternity hospitals belonging to the Hiroshima
Midwife Association

- (3) Home Visit: Fee 1,000 yen

Health exam for 1 month-old infants (*1-kagetsu-ji Kenko Shinsa*, 1か月児健康診査)

This is an individual health check. You will be given information about this when you receive your Mother and Child Health Handbook. Your child's physical measurements will be taken and he/she will be examined by a pediatrician.

Health exam for 4 month-old infants (*4-kagetsu-ji Kenko Shinsa*, 4か月児健康診査)

Enquiries: Children and Family Support Division (Tel: 082-420-0407)

This is an individual health check for 4 month-old infants, where physical measurements are taken, and any problems in motor development can be discovered. There are also medical examinations by pediatricians. In addition, the checkup includes explanations on the preparation of baby foods (weaning foods) and how to receive vaccinations. Families with an infant in the applicable age range will be notified of this health exam in advance.

Health exam for 18-month-old infants (*1-sai 6-kagetsu-ji Kenko Shinsa*, 1歳6か月児健康診査)

This is a group health checkup for 18-month old infants. Physical measurements are taken, and there are also medical examinations by pediatricians and dentists. In addition, the checkup includes consultations regarding foods for infants, development, and tooth-brushing. Families with an infant in the applicable age range will be notified of this health exam in advance.

Health exam for 3-year-old infants (*3-sai-ji Kenko Shinsa*, 3歳児健康診査)

This is a group health checkup for 3-year-old infants (when they are 3 years and 5 months of age). Physical measurements are taken, urine tests are conducted and vision is checked, and medical examinations by pediatricians and dentists are provided. In addition, the checkup includes consultations regarding infant foods, child-raising, child development, and tooth-brushing. Families with an infant in the applicable age range will be notified of this health exam in advance.

Childhood vaccinations (予防接種)

Around 6 months of age, infants start to lose the immunity inherited from their mothers and need to develop immunity on their own. Receiving vaccinations at the appropriate time helps prevent infants from contracting infectious diseases. There is no individual notification of the schedule of vaccinations.

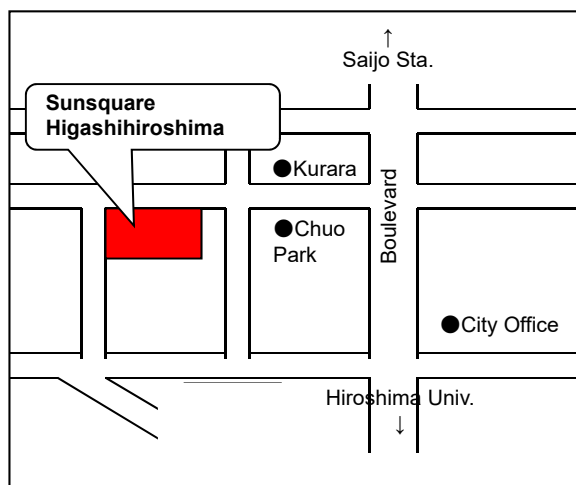

Family Support Center (ファミリー・サポート・センター)

Provider members render childcare support on a paid-for basis according to the requests of the client members, such as seeing off and meeting children when they attend nursery school or an '*Iki-iki Kodomo Club*', or and looking after children. Membership registration is necessary before taking advantage of this service.

- Membership registration: Please apply to the Family Support Center, to the Children and Family Support Division, or to a branch office of the City Office. Applications for membership are accepted at any time.
- Children shall be looked after at the provider members' homes as a general rule.
- Although the services may be available early in the morning or late at night, children do not stay over at provider members' homes as a general rule.
- In addition, children with a fever or illness cannot be looked after.

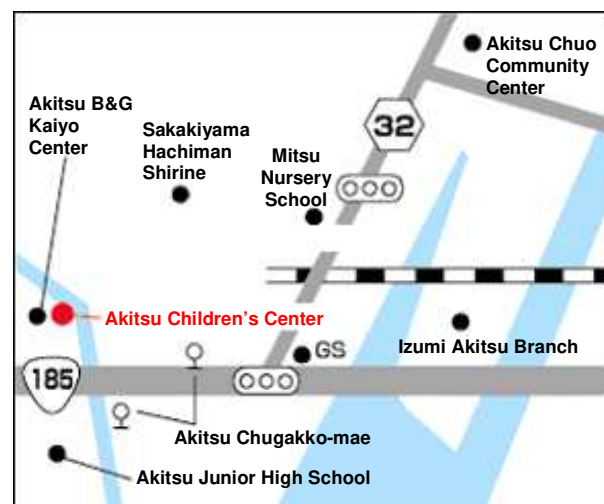

Child-raising Circles and Salons (子育てサークル・子育てサロン)

Child-raising Circles are independent groups in which parents/guardians who are raising children come together to play with their children in a community setting, and to hold seasonal events, etc. The groups meet regularly, and members help each other with child-raising, etc.

Child-raising Salons are child-raising support activities held regularly in the community. These salons are held by child welfare volunteers and local support workers.

Child-raising Circles and Salons are also places where parents/guardians can share information related to child-raising with each other. Please enquire for more details.

Pre-nursery school children and their parents/caregivers are able to use nursery school, approved kodomo-en, and kindergarten playgrounds. Short Stay (Short stay life support care service (*Tanki Nyusho Seikatsu Enjo*, 短期入所生活援助))

If parents/caregivers temporarily have difficulty taking care of their children due to illness or other reasons, their children can be taken care of in a facility for about one week.

Twilight Stay (Nighttime care) (*Yakan Yogo-to*, 夜間養護等)

If parents/caregivers have difficulty taking care of their children during nighttime or on holidays due to work or other reasons, their children can be taken care of in a facility for a certain period of time.

Before- and After-Childbirth 'Mama Helper' Scheme (*Sanzen/Sango Mama Helper Haken Jigyo*, 産前・産後ママヘルパー派遣事業)

Supporters can be dispatched to give advice about or help with child-raising or household chores, in the

period before and after a woman gives birth.

- Target: pregnant women who do not have anyone close they can talk to, or anyone who can support them while pregnant or after giving birth, with child care, etc.
- Period: Before giving birth: women who have been given their Mother and Child Health Handbook, but have not yet reached their due date
After giving birth: women are within six months of the day after their due date (in the case of multiple births, within one year of the days after the due date)
- Content: daily life support (listening to the woman's problems, etc.), and help with preparing for the birth, child-raising, household chores, etc.
- Cost: 1,000 yen per session (90 minutes), up to 2 times per day. For households receiving welfare support (seikatsu hogo), or households exempt from municipal tax, the service is free.
- Maximum use: 15 times each, before and after giving birth (30 times for mothers who have given birth to multiple children)

Multiple Childbirth Supporter Scheme (Tatai Ninshin Supporter Haken-jigyo, 多胎産婦サポーター派遣事業)

Supporters can be dispatched to families raising children born as twins, triplets, etc., to provide assistance with child-raising, going out, etc.

- Target: Those in families raising children born as twins, triplets, etc., who ask for assistance when going out, support for child-raising, etc.
- Period: until the children in question become 2 years old.
- Content: support and assistance with child-raising, when going out, etc., and listening to the woman's concerns, problems, etc.
- Cost: free

Individual consultations regarding food and lifestyle will be provided by dieticians and health nurses for those who suffer from allergic illnesses such as atopic dermatitis or bronchial asthma. Appointments are required.

Infant education and childcare was made free (幼児教育・保育の無料化)

There is a system by which childcare fees are free for children enrolled in classes for three- to five-year olds at kindergarten, nursery school, etc. However, some facilities may charge fees over a certain amount. Also, fees for lunches, transport costs, etc., are still payable.

Please note that it is necessary to obtain 'recognition of need for childcare' in advance. Formalities may vary depending on the facility, so please enquire at the Child Care Division, or at the kindergarten or nursery school, etc., in question.

Admission to a nursery school (保育所への入所)

Enquiries: Child Care Division (Tel: 082-420-0934)

Nursery schools are designed to take care of pre-elementary school infants and toddlers from when they are 0 years old for parents/caregivers who cannot take care of them at home due to work, attending school, or illness. Admission is limited to children who meet the above-mentioned conditions.

There are public and private nursery schools, both of which satisfy the standards of nursery schools, and are not in principle different in their services.

- How to apply: Please apply for admission at the Child Care Division or at the relevant counter at branch offices of the City Office. For admission in months other than April, please apply by the 25th day of the month two before the month in which you wish to enroll your child (for example, for admission from August, please apply by the end of June). If the 25th day of that month is a day on which the City Office is closed, then the deadline is the next day on which the City Office is open. For admission in April, please refer to the details posted on the city website around October the previous year.
- Childcare fee: Fees are decided individually based on the amount of income tax and municipal tax paid by the household in the previous year.
- Note: There may be cases where admission to a desired nursery school is difficult due to insufficient capacity, etc., at the nursery school.

Authorized childcare facilities provides two types of childcare services, which is extended hours childcare and temporary childcare. There may be cases some authorized childcare facilities does not provide the services, so please see the separate 'List of Nursery Schools'.

Extended Hours Childcare (*Encho Hoiku*, 延長保育)

Enquiries: Each nursery school providing extended hours childcare services

This service is available for parents/caregivers who cannot make it to the nursery school to drop off or pick up their children within the regular opening hours due to unavoidable reasons, for example working

hours.

- How to apply: Please apply directly to the nursery school.
- Fee: The fee varies depending on the nursery school.

Temporary Childcare (*Ichiji Hoiku*, 一時保育)

Enquiries: Each nursery school providing temporary childcare services

This service is available for parents/caregivers who need emergency/temporary childcare help because of such reasons as their work, urgent business, or illness, or in order to reduce the burden of child-raising. However, there may be cases where your child cannot be accepted due to conditions such as the nursery school in question being full.

- How to apply: Please apply directly to the nursery school.
- Opening hours: Mon. - Fri., 8:30 – 16:30 in principle
- Note: Childcare hours and fees may differ between nursery schools.

There are three types of authorized childcare facilities, nursery school, approved kodomo-en, and small-scale childcare facility.

Approved Kodomo-en (*Nintei kodomo-en*, 認定子ども園)

These are facilities where a nursery school and kindergarten are operated together.

Please apply for admission of a nursery school at the Child Care Division or the relevant counter at a branch office of the city. Application for kindergarten, please contact the kindergarten directly.

Small-scale Nurseries (*Shokibo hoiku*, 小規模保育)

These are nurseries with between 6 and 19 children, aimed at infants between 0 and 2 years of age.

At the time of graduation, your child can apply other authorized childcare facilities, etc., if they wish.

List of Childcare Facilities (*Hoiku-shisetsu ichiran*, 保育施設一覧)

For a list of authorized childcare facilities in Higashihiroshima City, please see the 'List of Authorized Childcare Facilities in Higashihiroshima City'.

Non-Authorized Childcare Facilities (*Ninkagai hoiku shisetsu*, 認可外保育施設)

These are facilities which have not received official authorization, but which have submitted notifications to the City as required by the Child Welfare Law.

Details of services available, childcare fees, etc. differ between facilities, and applications for admission are made directly to the facility concerned. For more details, please contact the facility concerned directly.

6. Elementary schools (*Shogakko*, 小学校)

Japan has a 6-3-3-4 education system, which consists of nine years of compulsory education – six years of elementary school (for children aged from 6 to 12) and three years of junior high school (children aged from 12 to 15) – followed by three years of high school and four years of university. The new academic year starts in April. Foreign residents are not required to enroll their children in school, but may have them admitted or transferred to the appropriate grade in an elementary or junior high school in Higashihiroshima City once they reach school age. Please consult the School Affairs Division if you wish to have your child enrolled in one of these schools. Admission, tuition and textbooks at municipal elementary and junior high schools are all free of charge. Expenses for teaching materials, school supplies, school lunches, outings and school trips must be covered by parents/caregivers.

[Health check before elementary school (*Shugaku-ji Kenshin*, 就学時健診)]

Information about the health check will be sent out by the end of September.

If you have not received the information by the end of September, please contact the School Affairs Division.



[Delivery of School Enrollment Notification (*Nyugaku Tsuchisho*, 入学通知書)]

Notification of the date of your child's admission to school and the elementary school they will attend (*Nyugaku-kijitsu oyobi Gakkoshitei Tsuchisho*, 入学期日及び学校指定通知書) will be sent out by the end of January in the year your child is scheduled to enter elementary school. If you do not receive the notification, please contact the School Affairs Division.



[Orientation Meetings for Parents of New Students (*Nyugaku Setsumeikai*, 入学説明会)]

Between the end of January and the middle of February, orientation meetings are held at each school, to provide information regarding preparing for starting school.



[Admission to elementary school (*Nyugaku*, 入学)]

Your child's elementary school will be decided based on his/her address. However, in some cases, you may be able to change the designated school. (There may be limits depending on the status of school facilities, etc.) For more information, please contact the School Affairs Division.

Procedures for transferring to another school (転入学の手続き)

Procedures for transferring to another school (転入学の手続き)

Enquiries: School Affairs Division (Tel: 082-420-0975)

If you have moved into Higashihiroshima City from outside the city, or changed your address within Higashihiroshima City, please take the certificate of enrollment (*Zaigaku Shomeisho*, 在学証明書) and textbook grant certificate (*Kyokasho Kyuyo Shomeisho*, 教科書給与証明書) from your child's previous school to the school specified by the School Affairs Division (the City Office). However, this is not required if your child transfers to a school in the city from a school in another country. If you move to a place outside Higashihiroshima City, please obtain your child's certificate of enrollment, etc., from your child's current school and complete the procedures in the place to which you are moving.

Japanese Language Classes (*Nihongo Shido Gakkyu*, 日本語指導学級)

Enquiries: School Affairs Division (Tel: 082-420-0975)

Foreign students who are having difficulties in learning at school due to insufficient understanding of the Japanese language can receive Japanese language lessons, up to a maximum of 5-8 hours per week per student.

School Expense Subsidies (*Shugaku Enjo*, 就学援助)

Some of the expenses for elementary and junior high school may be subsidized for parents/caregivers who find it difficult to have their children attend school due to financial reasons. For details, please contact the School Affairs Division.

- Types of expenses which are subsidized:
 - Expenses for school supplies, necessary items for commuting to and from school, school supplies for starting school, school trips, school meals, field trips, medical treatment (for specified illnesses), graduation albums.
 - Expenses for sports equipment (junior high school only)
- How to apply:
 - Submit the application documents to your child's school after consultation with the school.
 - Applications are accepted at any time.

After School Children's Clubs (*Hokago Jido Club*, 放課後児童クラブ)

Iki-iki Kodomo Clubs (いきいきこどもクラブ) (After school children's clubs)

Enquiries: Youth Development Division (Tel: 082-420-0929)

These are facilities to take care of children who cannot be with their parents/caregivers at home after

school because of the parents/caregivers' work, illness, or for other reasons.

For the children's safety, they should as a rule be taken to and from their club by their parents/caregivers (except when the children are on their way from school to the club).

- Children entitled to use one of these clubs:

- Children going to the elementary school at which the club is held or living in the school zone of the elementary school.
- Children whose parents and all other persons living at the same residence are absent from home on an ongoing basis during after-school hours due to work or other unavoidable reasons.

- Service hours and fees:

You are required to pay separately for accident insurance (800 yen annually).

2. Saturday services:

Children living in a school zone with an Iki-iki Kodomo Club that is closed on Saturdays, can use another Iki-iki Kodomo Club in a neighboring area to their school that is open on Saturdays (a club in the same junior high school zone in principle).

3. Fee exemption system:

Households on welfare, households who are exempt from paying the income-graded portion of municipal tax, households whose residence has been damaged by fire, wind, floods, or earthquakes will be exempt from all types of fees. Children's parents/caregivers must apply for this system on their own.

*An application is required each academic year.

*Charges for snacks and teaching materials are not eligible for exemption.

- How to apply:

- Please note that it is necessary to apply for membership each year.
- The deadline for applications joining in April is the end of January.
- To join the club starting from another month, apply at the Youth Development Division or the relevant counter at a branch office of the city by the 15th of the month before the month from which you wish your child to join the club (except when joining the club during summer vacation and in

July, August and March).

- Even if you are still looking for work, you should complete the formalities for enrolling your child by the deadlines detailed above.

School Life Consultations (*Gakko Seikatsu Sodan*, 学校生活相談)

Mental health supporters and school counselors are available in municipal elementary and junior high schools for consultations.

Mental health supporters (心のサポーター)

- Details: Mental health supporters are available to talk to children about their problems or concerns. Please contact your child's school for details.
- Target: Students, parents/caregivers, and members of staff.

School counselors (スクールカウンセラー)

- Details: Specialist consultations are provided. For more details, please contact the school directly.
- Target: Students and parents/caregivers.

7. Support for Single-parent families (ひとり親家庭への支援)

Subsidies & allowances (助成・手当など)

Subsidies for medical costs of single-parent families, etc. (*Hitori-oya katei-to iryo-hi no josei*, ひとり親家庭等医療費の助成)

Enquiries: Children and Family Support Division (Tel: 082-420-0941)

There are subsidies for medical costs of single-parent families. Eligibility certificates will be issued to those eligible for these subsidies. Please present your eligibility certificate at the counter of a medical institution. To apply for the subsidy, contact the relevant division in advance.

- Target: Fathers/mothers and their children in single-parent families raising a child aged up to 18. where the household is exempt from paying income tax. Eligibility applies until the first March 31 after the child has reached 18 years of age
- Subsidy details: The amount exceeding the amount payable as an individual contribution will be covered, for medical costs for which health insurance can be used.
(The amount payable as an individual contribution: Up to 500 yen per day per medical institution, for 14 days per month per medical institution for inpatients, and 4 days per month per medical institution for outpatients)

In the case of medicine and assistive devices (braces, etc.) from pharmacies where health insurance can be used (prescriptions filled outside the medical facility), there is no individual contribution payable.

- What to bring: The Health Insurance Certificates of all of your eligible household members, proof of your single-parent family status
- Note: The factors determining your eligibility for this subsidy (for example, income) are reviewed every year, and your eligibility certificate will be renewed on August 1.

If you change your address, name, or health insurance qualification, you must notify the relevant division.

Child-raising Allowance (*Jido Fuyo Teate*, 児童扶養手当)

Enquiries: Children and Family Support Division (Tel: 082-420-0941)

This allowance is paid to single-parent families raising a child aged up to 18. It is paid until the first March 31 after the child has reached 18 years old. There is an income limit for eligibility.

- What to bring: The applicant's and eligible child's Health Insurance Certificates, a bankbook in the name of the applicant, a document showing the pension number of the applicant, the lease/rental agreement for your accommodation, etc..
- Note: You must submit a notification of present circumstances (*Genkyo-todoke*, 現況届) in August every year. (The relevant documents will be mailed from the City Office in advance.)

When this allowance has been paid to a person for five years or more, part of the allowance may be stopped if that person has, without having any special reasons, shown no willingness to work.

Welfare Loan Fund for One-Parent Families and Widows (*Boshi/Fushi Kafu Fukushi-kin no Kashitsuke*, 母子・父子寡婦福祉資金の貸付)

Enquiries: Children and Family Support Division (Tel: 082-420-0407)

This is a system by which Hiroshima Prefecture loans funds to mothers and fathers in one-parent families, and to widows.

- Types of loans: Funds for preparation for school (educational expenses when advancing to the next level of education), tuition fees (tuition fees when advancing to the next level of education), etc.

- What to bring: Full copy of your family register, Certificate of Residence (*Juminhyo*, 住民票), Certificate of Income and Tax (*Shotoku Kazei Shomeisho*, 所得課税証明書), a bankbook in the name of the applicant, name seal, document showing the applicant's individual number ('My Number'), proof of identity (Residence Card)

Since what to bring differs according to the type of loan, please contact the relevant division in advance.

Grant for Advanced Job Training (*Koto Shokugyo Kunren Sokushin Kyufu-kin*, 高等職業訓練促進給付金), Grant for Advanced Job Training Curriculum Completion (*Koto Shokugyo Kunren shuryo Kyufu-kin*, 高等職業訓練修了給付金), and Benefits for Independence Support & Training (*Jiritsushien Kyoiku Kunren Kyufu-kin*, 自立支援教育訓練給付金)

Enquiries: Children and Family Support Division (Tel: 082-420-0407)

Subsidies are available for expenses incurred when single mothers train for advanced skills or obtain qualifications. Since there are limitations regarding the training courses covered and income limits for eligibility, etc., please consult the relevant division before attending any training courses.

- Types:

- ◆ Grant for Advanced Job Training (target: training for nursery school teachers, nurses, care workers, etc.)

This grant is paid monthly from the month of application, for the entire period of a one-year or longer curriculum.

- ◆ Grant for Advanced Job Training Curriculum Completion

This can be applied for after the period of the course is completed.

- ◆ Benefits for Independence Support Education and Training (target: training for newly-qualified nurses, medical office staff, etc.)

You must apply for this benefit prior to the start of the course. 60% of the expenses will be subsidized (there is a subsidy limit).

Since what to bring differs according to the type of grant and the conditions of the grant, please contact the relevant division in advance.

Discount for purchasing JR commuter passes (*JR Tsukin Teiki Konyu Waribiki*, JR 通勤定期購入割引)

If a person receiving Child-raising Allowance commutes to work using JR, a discount certificate (*Waribiki Shomeisho*, 割引証明書) can be issued for purchasing a commuter pass.

8. Preventing Abuse (虐待防止)

Main types of abuse (虐待の主な種類)

- Physical abuse
Punching, kicking or strangling a child, locking a child out of the home, burning a child with a lit cigarette, scalding a child with boiling water, etc.
- Mental abuse
Directly telling a child, ‘I wish you had never been born’, treating a child differently from his or her brothers and sisters, using violence against a spouse in front of a child, etc.
- Sexual abuse
Rape, forced sex, sexual assault, forcing a child to see sexual acts, forcing a child to be a subject of pornography
- Neglect (child-raising abandonment and negligence)
Not providing a child with proper meals, not allowing a child to take a bath, abandoning a child in a house or a car, leaving the child’s environment or clothes extremely dirty, not controlling a situation where the child experiences assault from persons living in the same residence

10. Parks・Libraries (公園・図書館)

<Parks>

Roadside Station 'Kohan-no-sato Fukutomi' (*Michi-no-eki 'Kohan-no-sato Fukutomi'*, 道の駅「湖畔の里福富」)

Kohan-no-sato Fukutomi, which is on the Route 375 Bypass, is situated in a location with beautiful scenery, surrounded by the waters of Fukutomi Dam.

There are large pieces of play equipment for children to play with for free. At the day campsite, barbecues can be enjoyed, and the Multipurpose Ground, the Hands-on Learning Room and Multipurpose Hall are also available for use by parents and children, and by groups.

- Closed: Open seven days a week (the restaurant is closed on Wednesdays)

- Access: Approximately 30 minutes by car from Sanyo Expressway Shiwa IC

Kagamiyama Park (*Kagamiyama Koen*, 鏡山公園)

This is a general park located on the Boulevard, in the southern part of the Saijo city area. In the park, which is equipped with play equipment, Mt. Kagamiyama embraces the remains of Kagamiyama Castle. Kagamiyama Park is also a tourist attraction with its Cherry Blossom Garden (*Sakura-enchi*, 桜園地), in which 33 types of cherry trees (approximately 500 trees in total) have been planted.

- Location: 2-chome, Kagamiyama

- Access: 10 minutes by bus or 30 minutes on foot from JR Saijo Station
15 minutes by bus from JR Higashihiroshima Station
20 minutes by car from Sanyo Expressway Saijo IC

Ikoimori Park (*Ikoimori Koen*, 憩いの森公園)

It is located at the southern foot of Mt. Ryuo, to the north of the center of Saijo-cho. The observation platform at the top of the mountain commands fine views of the townscape of Saijo-cho, of the Noro mountain range to the south, and, on fine days, of the mountain range of Shikoku.

In spring, a total of 2,000 cherry trees blossom in this park, especially in the cherry forest near the top of the mountain. The park is criss-crossed with paths, and is equipped with various facilities, including a multipurpose open square, the Mountain Stream Square, the Children's Square, a day campsite, a forest camping area, an auto campsite, and so on. The Children's Square offers play equipment for children to play with. This park can be used in diverse ways in every season, such as playing in the water in the Mountain Stream Square, barbecues at the day campsite, and so on.

Mitsujo Tumulus (*Mitsujo Kofun*, ミツ城古墳) (next to the Central Library)

One of the largest keyhole-shaped tombs in Hiroshima Prefecture, measuring 92m in length, is situated in Saijo-chuo. It is said that the name of the tumulus- 'Mitsujo (three castles) Tumulus'- comes from the fact that it consists of three elevated parts- the first tomb's front part and round rear part, and the second tomb. It is thought that these are the tombs of an ancient baronial family, and a study revealed that the first tomb was constructed in the first half of the 5th Century. Currently, this area, as Mitsujo Park, is equipped with open squares and play equipment for children to play near the tumulus, and is visited by many families with children during holidays.

Roadside Station 'Saijo Nonta no Sakagura' (道の駅西条のん太の酒蔵)

The roadside station 'Saijo Nonta no Sakagura' is located along the National Route 2 Saijo bypass. In the indoor playground equipment theater 'Kodomo Hiroba', children can play with playground equipment and toys without worrying about the weather or the season. There is also an infant space and tatami space, and there are diaper changing sheets, nursing rooms, water heaters, etc. near the children's area, so families with small children can use it with confidence.

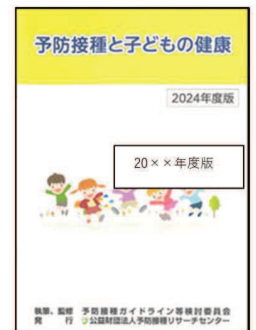

■ If you have your child vaccinated outside Higashihiroshima City: 

It is necessary to complete formalities in advance

Please apply online, at the Medical Treatment and Health Division, or at a Branch Office (except Fukutomi Branch Office). The process may take 1-2 weeks.

If you have your child vaccinated outside the city, you may have to pay a fee.

Routine vaccinations (free for those in the target age range)

Vaccinations are regulated by the Vaccination Act, and the type, target populations, and vaccination periods are set out. They are primarily focused on the prevention of mass infection and the prevention of serious diseases. It is recommended that children receive them wherever possible, and the individual (guardian) has an obligation to make an effort to have their child vaccinated. Please get your child vaccinated wherever possible during the recommended vaccination period.
