Classes take place in the study room on the second floor of the Citizens' Culture Center (Sunsquare Higashihiroshima). The tuition fee for the course is 2000 yen for each class. Water charges are changing from April

4月から水道料金が変わり

From April, the basic charge for water supply will be reduced by 9%. For example, the basic charge for household water supply will change from 3,478 yen to 3,160 yen. The charge for water over the basic charge will be kept as it is at present.

For water bills issued on or after Tuesday March 1st, it is possible to read the bill and pay it using a smartphone application. Applications that can be used are as follows: J-Coin Bill Payment, auPAY (bill payment), PayPay Bill Payment, bank payment applications (Yucho Pay, etc.), Rakuten Ginko Convenience Store Payment Service, LINEPay Bill Payment, PayB.

If you need a receipt, please pay at a convenience store or financial institution shown on the bill, or at the Waterworks Department (or branch offices).

30% refund campaign for cashless payments

If you make a purchase, etc., in a shop in Higashihiroshima City using an eligible cashless payment method, you can receive points in proportion to the amount you spend.

The period of the campaign is from Friday April 22nd to Tuesday May 31st. Purchases can be made in shops, etc. that have introduced an eligible cashless payment method (except convenience stores and large chain stores). Eligible payment methods are auPAY, d-Barai, and Rakuten Pay.

30% of the purchase will be refunded as points. The limit for refunds is 3000 yen per transaction, and 20000 per person (per payment method).

It is possible to pay municipal taxes by bank account transfer. This is a convenient way of ensuring you do not forget to make a payment (the payments will be taken from your bank account on the deadline dates shown above). Applications to make use of this service can be made at the service counters of the City Office, the Branch Offices, and the Subbranch Offices. Alternatively, financial institutions with branches within Higashihiroshima City can handle applications. If you pay by payment slip, you will be sent a slip for the whole payment, as well as slips for each individual payment. Please take care not to pay twice.

Special One-Off Payments to Households Raising Children	•子育 •	て世帯への臨時特別給 付金

Special one-off payment for those with new-born infants

A special one-off payment for those with new-born infants is now available.

Those who are raising a child born between September 1st 2021 and March 31st 2022 and whose income is at or under a level that would qualify them for child allowance payments are eligible to receive the payment.

Applications for the one-off payment for children aged 18 and under are now no longer being accepted.

Support payment

A support payment will be made to those who were not able to receive the 2021 financial year special one-off payment to households raising children, but are raising children because of divorce, etc.

Those who as a result of divorce, etc., have become the caregiver for a child of 18 or under (a child born between April 2nd 2003 and March 31st 2022) by Monday February 28th, and whose income is at or under a level that would qualify them for child allowance payments, are eligible to receive the payment.

The deadline for applications for either of the payments is Thursday April 28th. To apply, please send the application form to the Children and Family Support Division by post, or take it in person. The application form can be downloaded from the City website.

The pension handbook system has been changed to a system of notices of Basic Pension Number

From April 2022, pension handbooks will be abolished, and those who newly enrol into the pension scheme, or those who lose their pension handbook and request it to be reissued will be issued with a notice of their Basic Pension Number.

If you already have a pension handbook, you will be not be issued with a notice of your Basic Pension Number. Please continue to keep your pension handbook safe.

Deadline for payment of taxes: Monday May 2nd

Please pay Fixed Asset Tax and City Planning Tax (the first payment) by Monday May 2nd.

A notice of non-payment (Tokusokujo, 督促状) will be sent to residents who have not paid their tax by the deadline. If you receive a Tokusokujo, please pay the tax immediately, using the payment slip enclosed.

* Note: it takes about ten days for the Tax Collection Division to confirm payment of tax, and therefore you may receive a Tokusokujo even after you have completed payment. In this case, please ignore the letter.

Night-time and holiday hospitals

• Night-time and holiday duty hospitals: Full information about night-time and holiday duty hospitals within Higashihiroshima City is published in the Japanese-language version of the monthly city newsletter 'Higashihiroshima' (the page inside the back cover: only in Japanese), and on the Higashihiroshima City website (in Japanese and English). The information is subject to change at short notice, so before going to a medical facility, please be sure to call to confirm details.

Recently, there are more and more patients using emergency medical facilities at night and on holidays even though their situation is not serious. In some cases, these patients have prevented or delayed the treatment of patients with truly serious illnesses, and

additionally, such cases are one of the reasons for doctors becoming overworked. Emergency medical facilities open at night and on holidays are for patients with serious, emergency conditions. Please try to visit the medical facility you use normally, during opening hours on weekdays.

• Emergency medical treatment for children: Please call the advice line on #8000 (if you cannot get through on this number, please call 082-505-1399). The service is available every day between 19:00 and 8:00 the following morning. Also, advice is available on the website (you can access the website from the QR code to the right), in Japanese, English, and Chinese (simplified and traditional). You can obtain information about whether or not you should take your child to a medical facility outside of normal opening hours (at nights, on weekends or holidays, etc.).

• If you have a medical problem at night or on weekends, and you are unsure about whether or not you should go to a medical facility: Please call the Hiroshima area emergency consultation center on #7119. The service is free, and is available 24 hours a day, 365 days a year. The staff will be able to give you advice on

whether to rest at home and see how symptoms develop, or whether you should go to a medical facility. If necessary, they can give you information about which facility to go to, or they can connect you directly to the 119 emergency service. In an emergency, do not hesitate to phone 119.
