# System of tests for rubella (German measles) antibodies, and subsidies for the cost of vaccination

・風しんの抗体検査・予防接

Rubella (German measles) is a very infectious illness that spreads easily from person to person by means of droplet infection (coughing, etc.). The main symptoms of the illness are a fever and a rash.

A system of tests for rubella antibodies, and subsidies for the cost of vaccination, is being introduced across the country. Under this system of subsidies, it will be possible to be checked for antibodies at any participating medical facility across the country. Even if an individual only wishes to be vaccinated, as a rule it will be necessary to be checked for antibodies.

Men born between April 2<sup>nd</sup> 1962 and April 1<sup>st</sup> 1979 are eligible for the check and subsidy under the system. To be checked for antibodies and to be vaccinated under the system, you will need a coupon issued by the city. These coupons will be sent out from around the end of April.

There is a dedicated human rights counselling telephone service available for those who cannot speak Japanese well. Available languages are English, Chinese, Korean, Filipino, Portuguese, and Vietnamese.

You can make use of this service from anywhere in Japan, by dialling 0570-090911 (please be careful that you do not dial the wrong number). The service is available on weekdays (year-end/new year period excepted) from 9:00 to 17:00. When you make use of this service, you will be connected to a company providing multi-language telephone interpretation, and you will be able to speak to a regional Legal Affairs Bureau.

# Deadline for payment of taxes: Tuesday May 7th

Please pay Fixed Asset Tax and City Planning Tax (the first payment) by Tuesday May 7th.

A notice of non-payment (Tokusokujo, 督促状) will be sent to residents who have not paid their tax by the deadline. If you receive a Tokusokujo, please pay the tax immediately, using the payment slip enclosed.

\* Note: it takes about ten days for the Tax Collection Division to confirm payment of tax, and therefore you may receive a Tokusokujo even after you have completed payment. In this case, please ignore the letter.

You will be able to find information about which medical facility to go to, and what times the facilities are open. The information on the site may be subject to change at short notice, so please contact the medical facility to confirm the information.

#### About emergency medical treatment

In the case of an injury or a sudden fever or illness, where you cannot decide whether the symptoms are serious or not, first of all go to a 'Primary Emergency Medical Care Hospital'. If the symptoms are serious, and emergency surgery or hospitalization is required, the doctor will provide an introductory letter for a 'Secondary Emergency Medical Care Hospital'. If the symptoms are clearly serious, do not hesitate to go to a Secondary Emergency Medical Care Hospital, or call 119 to summon an ambulance. For details of Secondary Emergency Medical Care hospitals, where patients with serious symptoms can be treated, contact Higashihiroshima City Fire Department (tel.: 082-422-0119).

Higashihiroshima City Holiday Clinic (Kyujitsu Shinryosho, 休日診療所) is a facility that can provide emergency treatment in the case of a sudden medical problem, for those who cannot get treatment anywhere else. Whenever possible, please visit a medical facility during opening hours on a weekday. Holiday clinic medical Departments: internal medicine, pediatrics and dentistry.
Open: Sundays, holidays, year-end and New Year holidays (Dec. 30 - Jan. 3). Hours: 9:00 - 12:00, 13:00 - 16:00

On Sunday April 28th, Monday April 29th, and Monday April 30th, only the dentistry department will be open.

**Call Center for Emergency First-aid for Children** (Kodomo-kyukyu-denwa-sodan, こどもの救急電話相談), tel.: #8000 (from a normal phone or mobile phone) or 082-505-1399 (from an IP phone or hikari phone). Available 365 days a year, from 19:00 to 8:00 the following morning. Only in Japanese.
