新年交流会



Help with applications for 'My Number' cards (at the Citizens' Affairs ・マイナンバーカード申請キ Division)

Help with applying for a 'My Number' card (completing the application form, getting a photograph taken) will be available at the Citizens' Affairs Division between Tuesday January 15th and Thursday January 31st (except Saturdays and Sundays), from 8:30 to 16:00.

Those who fall into all of the following categories can make use of this service:

- 1. Those who are registered as citizens of Higashihiroshima City.
- 2. Those who have not yet applied for a My Number card.
- 3. Those who have no plans to move house within the city, or move out of the city, within two months of applying for the card.
- 4. Those who can come to the City Office in person.

The service is only available at the Citizens' Affairs Division in the City Office, not at branch offices or sub-branch

When applying, the following are necessary:

- · Officially-issued identification (the original document, not a copy): One piece of identification from group A, or two pieces from group B (see the examples to the right).
- · Your 'My Number' notification card (if you have lost this, you may need to visit the City Office twice.)
- Your Basic Resident Registration Card (if you have one)
- · Your personal stamp (a rubber 'Shachihata' stamp is not acceptable)

For those under 15, or adult wards, the necessary items are different. Please check in advance what is needed.

The automatic certificate issuing machine is no longer available, but if you have a Citizen's Identification Card (Seal Registration Card), please keep this carefully, as it is still needed if you need to have a personal seal registration certificate issued at a counter of the City Office.

Group A documents (with a

photo of the holder's face)

e.g. driving license, passport, Basic Resident Registration Card, Residence Card, physically disabled person's handbook, mentally disabled person's health and welfare handbook, Certificate of Special Permanent Residence, etc.

Group B documents (showing name and date of birth, or name and address)

e.g. health insurance certificate, pension handbook, student ID, medical care certificate, etc.



It's useful to have a My Number card in the following sorts of situations!

- •If you need officially-issued photo identification.
- If it's inconvenient to go to the City Office to get a certificate of residency or a personal seal registration certificate (with a My Number card, you can get these certificates at convenience stores across Japan).

Eye tests using a spot vision screener

Notice of Medical Expenses (usable when claiming deductions for ・医療費控除に使用できる「医 medical expenses)

It is possible to obtain a 'Notice of Medical Expenses', which shows details of medical expenses paid during 2018. This can be used when making a claim for deductions from income tax, etc., for medical expenses paid. If you require one of these documents, please request one, by phone or in person.

The documents are only available for those enrolled in the National Health Insurance scheme. When applying, please take identification (a driving license, Residence Card, etc.) with you.

Documents showing expenses paid between January and November 2018 can be issued from Wednesday January 16th. Documents showing expenses paid between January and December 2018 can be issued from Monday February 18th.

There is only one month left to take the 'Genki Sukoyaka' health check! • 「元気すこやか検診」の受 診期間は残り1カ月!

The final day on which you can take the 'Genki Sukoyaka' health check at a medical facility is Thursday January 31st. The health check is available to citizens of Higashihiroshima City aged 40 and over, and to female citizens aged 20 or over (even-number ages only). Ages are calculated as of March 31st, 2019. If you have lost your examination voucher, these can be re-issued.

Please pay Municipal and Prefectural Tax (the fourth installment) and the National Health Insurance Premium (the seventh installment) by Thursday January 31st.

A notice of non-payment (Tokusokujo, 督促状) will be sent to residents who have not paid their tax by the deadline. If you receive a Tokusokujo, please pay the tax immediately, using the payment slip enclosed.

* Note: it takes about ten days for the Tax Collection Division to confirm payment of tax, and therefore you may receive a Tokusokujo even after you have completed payment. In this case, please ignore the letter.

Night-time and holiday hospitals

Full information about night-time and holiday duty hospitals (Primary Emergency Medical Care Hospitals) within Higashihiroshima City is published in the Japanese-language version of the monthly city newsletter 'Higashihiroshima' (the page inside the back cover), and on the Higashihiroshima City website:

The information is also available (in Japanese and automatically-translated English) on the 'Kyukyu Iryo Net Hiroshima' site (http://www.qq.pref.hiroshima.jp). You will be able to find information about which medical facility to go to, and what times the facilities are open. The information on the site may be subject to change at short notice, so please contact the medical facility to confirm the information.

About emergency medical treatment

In the case of an injury or a sudden fever or illness, where you cannot decide whether the symptoms are serious or not, first of all go to a 'Primary Emergency Medical Care Hospital'. If the symptoms are serious, and emergency surgery or hospitalization is required, the doctor will provide an introductory letter for a 'Secondary Emergency Medical Care Hospital'. If the symptoms are clearly serious, do not hesitate to go to a Secondary Emergency Medical Care Hospital, or call 119 to summon an ambulance. For details of Secondary Emergency Medical Care hospitals, where patients with serious symptoms can be treated, contact Higashihiroshima City Fire Department (tel.: 082-422-0119).

Higashihiroshima City Holiday Clinic (Kyujitsu Shinryosho, 休日診療所) is a facility that can provide emergency treatment in the case of a sudden medical problem, for those who cannot get treatment anywhere else. Whenever possible, please visit a medical facility during opening hours on a weekday. Holiday clinic medical Departments: internal medicine, pediatrics and dentistry.

• Open: Sundays, holidays, year-end and New Year holidays (Dec. 30 - Jan. 3). Hours: 9:00 - 12:00, 13:00 - 16:00 Until Sunday March 10th, the internal medicine and pediatrics departments will be open until 20:00.

Call Center for Emergency First-aid for Children (Kodomo-kyukyu-denwa-sodan, こどもの救急電話相談), tel.: #8000 (from a normal phone or mobile phone) or 082-505-1399 (from an IP phone or hikari phone). Available 365 days a year, from 19:00 to 8:00 the following morning. Only in Japanese.
