Coronavirus (the 2019 novel coronavirus disease)

On Friday March 6th, the first case of the coronavirus disease was detected In Hiroshima Prefecture. In order to prevent the spread of the infection, please ensure that you are extremely careful when coughing, and be sure to wash your hands thoroughly and frequently. It is important that everyone takes steps to prevent the spread of the infection.

- •When you should seek advice:
- · If you have symptoms of a cold, or a fever of 37.5 degrees or more, that last for four days or more (this applies too to those who need to continue to take fever medicine)
- · If you feel extreme listlessness (weariness) or if you have difficulty breathing
- •In addition, if you are in the following groups, you are at greater risk of the disease becoming serious, so please seek advice without delay if you have the above symptoms for two days or more.
- You are elderly
- · You have an underlying disease such as diabetes, cardiac insufficiency, a respiratory disease (COPD, etc.), or you are undergoing dialysis
- · You are taking immunosuppressants or anti-cancer agents
- · You are pregnant
- •If you have been in, or returned from an endemic area **, and if you are concerned about your health, please contact the advice center below.

Endemic areas as of March 7th:

- · People's Republic of China: Hubei Province, Zhejiang Province
- · Republic of Korea (South Korea): Daegu Metropolitan City, Cheongdo-gun, North Gyeongsang Province, Gyeongsan-si, Andong-si, Yeongcheon-si, Chilgok-gun, Uiseong-gun, Seongju-gun, Gunwi-gun
- · Islamic Republic of Iran: Qom Province, Tehran Province, Gilan Province
- •Please pay attention to the following if you have to visit a medical facility having sought advice:

Please have yourself checked at the medical facility you were advised to go to by the advice center for returning persons and those who have been in contact with them. Please refrain from having yourself checked at multiple medical facilities.

When having yourself checked at a medical facility, please ensure that you take care to prevent the spread of any infection: wear a mask, wash your hands thoroughly and frequently, and be careful when coughing or sneezing (when coughing or sneezing, please use a mask, tissue, handkerchief or your sleeve to cover your mouth and nose).

It is possible to pay municipal taxes by bank account transfer. This is a convenient way of ensuring you do not forget to make a payment (the payments will be taken from your bank account on the deadline dates shown above). Applications to make use of this service can be made at the service counters of the City Office, the Branch Offices, and the Sub-branch Offices. Alternatively, financial institutions with branches within Higashihiroshima City can handle applications.

If you pay by payment slip, you will be sent a slip for the whole payment, as well as slips for each individual payment. Please take care not to pay twice.

Spring Horticulture Festival

This festival will take place on Saturday April 25th and Sunday April 26th, from 9:00 to 15:00.

The location is Higashihiroshima Horticulture Center (address: 10247 Beppu, Shiwa-cho). Admission is free.

There will be a market selling seedlings and local products from around the area. There will also be mini gardening lectures and advice sessions, and soil checks are also available. If you would like a soil check, please bring a dried sample of soil with you. Also, on both days of the festival, there will be a range of handson events, including vegetable picking and tree grafting (with persimmon trees). Also, at the end of the second day of the event, the flowers from the 'flower tower' will be handed out.

The event this year is part of the Hiroshima Hana-no-Wa program of events, being held until November 23rd.

Free admission to swimming pools on Children's Day (children's welfare month)

Two swimming pools will have free entrance for children (up to and including junior high school students) between Friday May 1st and Sunday May 3rd, and on Tuesday May 5th and Wednesday May 6th. The swimming pools are the Kurose Indoor Pool, and the pool at Akitsu B&G Kaiyo Center. The free entrance applies to children who are using the pool individually, not as part of an organized group.

Please have a rubella antibody test, and have yourself vaccinated if necessary

If you have still not had a rubella antibody test, or if as a result of your antibody test you have been judged to need vaccination, please go to a medical facility offering these tests and vaccinations.

To receive the subsidy available for the test and vaccination, you need to use a coupon issued by Higashihiroshima City. These coupons will not be issued in this financial year, so please use the coupon you were sent last year. The coupons were issued at the end of April 2019 to those eligible (males born between April 2nd, 1962 and April 1st, 1979).

If you have lost your coupon, or if you never received a coupon because you moved into Higashihiroshima City after the coupons were issued, etc., then the coupon can be reissued.

Deadline for payment of taxes: Thursday April 30th

Please pay Fixed Asset Tax and City Planning Tax (the first payment) by Thursday April 30th.

A notice of non-payment (Tokusokujo, 督促状) will be sent to residents who have not paid their tax by the deadline. If you receive a Tokusokujo, please pay the tax immediately, using the payment slip enclosed.

* Note: it takes about ten days for the Tax Collection Division to confirm payment of tax, and therefore you may receive a Tokusokujo even after you have completed payment. In this case, please ignore the letter.

Night-time and holiday hospitals

Night-time and holiday duty hospitals:

Full information about night-time and holiday duty hospitals within Higashihiroshima City is published in the Japanese-language version of the monthly city newsletter 'Higashihiroshima' (the page inside the back cover; only in Japanese), and on the Higashihiroshima City website (in Japanese and English).

The information is subject to change at short notice, so before going to a medical facility, please be sure to call to confirm details.

Recently, there are more and more patients using emergency medical facilities at night and on holidays even though their situation is not serious. In some cases, these patients have

prevented or delayed the treatment of patients with truly serious illnesses, and additionally, such cases are one of the reasons for doctors becoming overworked. Emergency medical facilities open at night and on holidays are for patients with serious, emergency conditions. Please try to visit the medical facility you use normally, during opening hours on weekdays.

Emergency medical treatment for children:

Please call the advice line on #8000 (if you cannot get through on this number, please call 082-505-1399). The service is available every day between 19:00 and 8:00 the following morning. Also, advice is available on the website (you can access the website from the QR code to the right), in Japanese, English, and Chinese (simplified and traditional). You can obtain information about whether or not you should take your child to a medical facility outside of normal opening hours (at nights, on weekends or holidays, etc.).



If you have a medical problem at night or on weekends, and you are unsure about whether or not you should go to a medical facility:

Please call the Hiroshima area emergency consultation center on #7119. The service is free, and is available 24 hours a day, 365 days a year. The staff will be able to give you advice on whether to rest at home and see how symptoms develop, or whether you should go to a medical facility. If necessary, they can give you information about which facility to go to, or they can connect you directly to the 119 emergency service.

In an emergency, do not hesitate to phone 119.
